

### ***LJTC Court Access Rules:***

- **Call 858.454.4434 (Pro Shop) 12 to 72 hours (3 days) in advance with names of participants to reserve a court.**
- **Ask for 1 hour for Singles or 1 1/2 hours for Doubles, giving time and court preference (2, 8, 9, & 6-evenings only).**

1. Only Members of the La Jolla Tennis Club may reserve courts.
2. Courts 2, 8, or 9 can be reserved. Court 6 after 5 pm can be reserved due to lack of lighting on 8 & 9 and court 2 being used by the teaching professionals.
3. No player may be identified in more than 1 reservation per day.
4. If all of the players are not at the court at the designated reservation time, the court may be given up to waiting players.
5. If a court is not reserved, it is available subject to the current court access procedures.

### **Procedure for all other courts plus 2, 8, 9, & 6 when not reserved:**

- Singles play is limited to 1 set and a warmup of 5 minutes. (12 Point Tie Breaker @ 6 All)
  - Doubles play is limited to 2 sets and a warmup of 5 minutes. (12 Point Tie Breaker @ 6 All)
  - Rallying is limited to 30 minutes. Set may not start after 5 minutes of rallying.
  - When all courts are in use, you ask between points how far along they are in their matches. Players should display scores eliminating need to ask.
  - Once you have selected a court, you must sit on the bench facing that court. Two players are required to wait for singles and 3 for doubles. Please enter through the proper gate between points.
  - Should one player retire before the completion of 2 sets in doubles, another player may play out the 2 set limit after which all 4 players shall retire.
  - If no players are waiting after the allotted sets, 1 set for singles or 2 sets for doubles, play may continue on a 1 set basis.
  - No player shall succeed himself on the same court when others are waiting.
  - 3 players get 1 set with a 5 minute warmup. (12 Point Tie Breaker @ 6 all.)
  - No more than 3 balls may be used when playing, rallying, or practicing serves except on courts 1 and 2.
  - An individual may practice on an open court, but must retire immediately if players arrive.
  - LJTC Tennis Club approved activities shall have priority on all courts.
  - Court #1 and #7 are for the use of the Club's teaching Professionals.
- When not in use, they are open for membership play.
- Players shall keep membership cards visible at all times.
